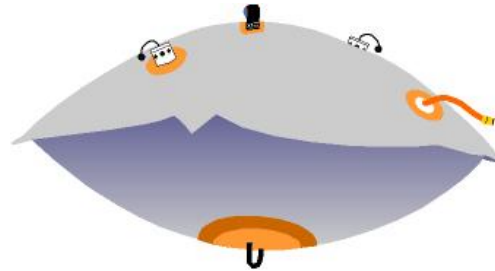


Underwater Air Lift Bags Descriptions



BOULDER BAGS

Illustrated here, the CBBB-2000 Boulder Bag.

- Great for use as air jacks to exert several thousand pounds of force over a large area

Boulder Bags derive their name from gold dredgers and nugget hunters who use them for lifting boulders in the shallow rivers of California's mother-love country. They are designed to get a maximum amount of lift from a single lift-point in a minimum depth of water. For example, the 2000-pound Boulder Bag gets its total lift in less than 3 feet of water, whereas the 2000-pound Open Bottom Bag requires almost 8 feet of water. These bags are very durable and have been used as air jacks capable of exerting several thousand pounds of force over a large area.
